Luke 15:4-6

- “What man among you, if he has a hundred sheep and has lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open pasture and go after the one which is lost until he finds it? ⁵ When he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing. ⁶ And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and his neighbors, saying to them, ‘Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!’

- “Or what woman, if she has ten silver coins and loses one coin, does not light a lamp and sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it?
⁹ When she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbors, saying, ‘**Rejoice with me**, for I have found the coin which I had lost!’¹⁰ In the same way, I tell you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”

- **John 16:20-22:** *“²⁰ Truly, truly, I say to you, that you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice; you will grieve, but your grief will be turned into joy. ²¹ Whenever a woman is in labor she has pain, because her hour has come;*

- **John 16:20-22:** *“but when she gives birth to the child, she no longer remembers the anguish because of the joy that a child has been born into the world. ²² Therefore you too have grief now; but I will see you again, and your heart will rejoice, and no one will take your joy away from you*

- **Luke 24:40-41** Having said this, He showed them His hands and feet. But while they still could not believe **because of their joy** and were amazed...
