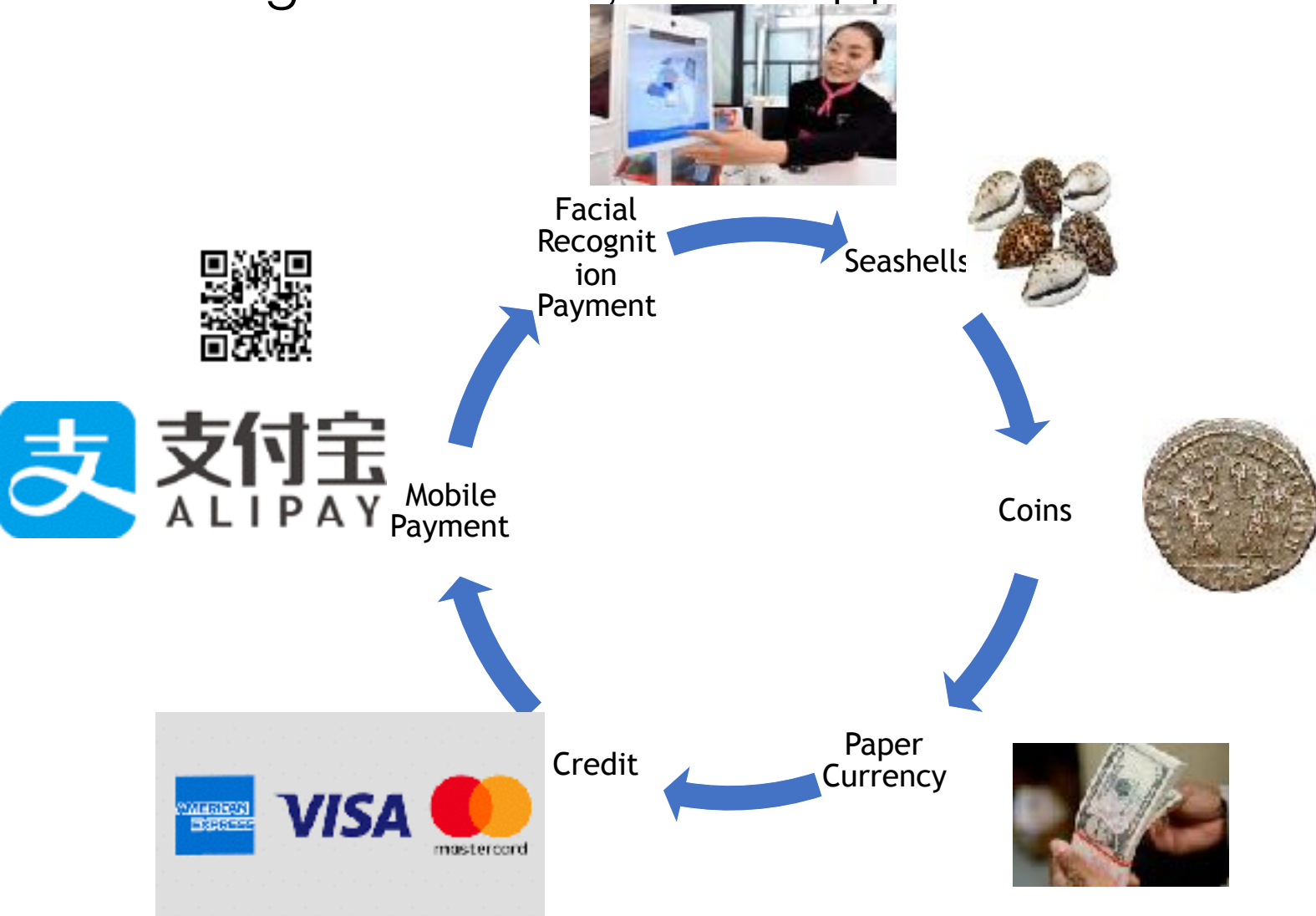

2. God the True Constant

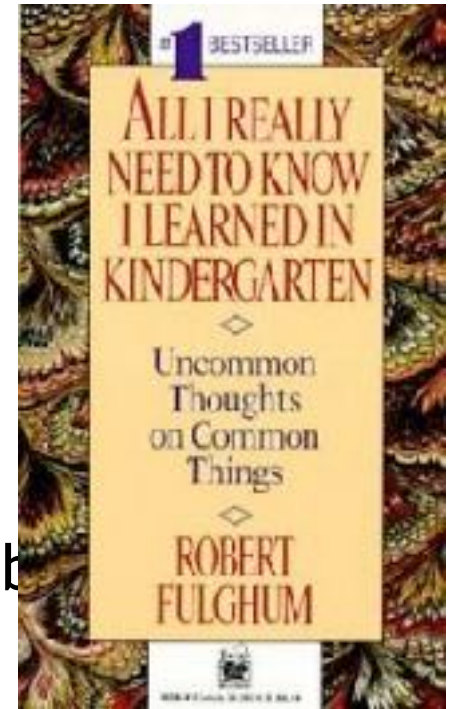
- God is Love and He Loves You and Me
