A. Dullness of perspective from the disciples (vs.5-7)

- Jesus wants us to learn to trust in Him to supply what seems impossible



B. Display of power from Jesus (vs.8-13)

- When we devote what little resources we have to the Lord, He takes it and multiplies it.



C. Disillusionment from the crowd (vs.14,15)

- Jesus was communicating that He could feed them spiritually, not just physically. The food was not the issue.
