1 Timothy 2:1-8

Background on 1 Timothy

Written in 64 AD → Paul writing to His disciple Timothy who is now pastoring a church in Ephesus.

Paul wrote 1st Timothy to talk about:

- Sound Doctrine
- What Godliness looks like in the Church
- Qualities of leadership in the church
- How Worship needs to look like

1 Timothy 2:1-8

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanks giving be made for all people — ² for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. ³ This is good, and pleases God our Savior, ⁴ who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

1 Timothy 2:1-8

⁵ For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, ⁶ who gave himself as a ransom for all people. I. WE MUST PRAY

"I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people"

Paul uses four different words:

- **Petitions** Sharing your needs and worries with God.
- Prayer <u>ALIGNING</u> your heart with God. Communion and Fellowship!
- Intercession Praying on behalf of someone else! For others!
- **Thanksgiving** PRAISING God for his blessings no matter WHAT our circumstances are. "Eucharistos"

I. WE MUST PRAY

PRAYER IS AN ADMISSION THAT WE CANNOT, BUT GOD CAN!!

Mark 10:27 \rightarrow ²⁷ Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God."

I. WE MUST PRAY

Prayer is relying solely on the power of the Holy Spirit

PREACHING AND PRAYER OF THE WORD IS IMPORTANT but His Power can only be accessed with the Spirit's prompting.

John 3:5-6 \rightarrow ⁵ Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. ⁶ Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.





²"...Prayer must be made for **all people**, for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness."

All People → We are quick to judge, but only God knows who will be saved. All people means every tribe, nation, tongue, and type of people.

For Kings and all those in Authority

In 64 AD \rightarrow Emperor Nero was the Emperor of Rome.

Great persecution was happening that prevented Christians from Gathering.

Five Reasons to Pray for Our Leaders:

- I. Our leaders need God's help.
- II. God knows our leaders are broken. So much so that He gave His son to bring redemption and provide hope for our eternal security.



III. God asks us to pray for our leaders, our loved ones, our neighbors, and ourselves.

¹⁴ if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. <u>2</u> <u>Chronicles 7:14</u>

IV. When we pray for our Leaders, we take part in advancing God's Kingdom on this earth.

Those who are in positions of power may have been allowed there by God for a specific purpose. When we pray for them, we are praying **that God's will be done.**

- V. When we pray for our Leaders, we ask God to fight against Spiritual Warfare
- It is important to remember that our leaders face spiritual battles and opposition that they may not be aware of (Ephesians 6:12). Rather than complain or be angry, we can fight through the power of prayer.

"....that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. ³ This is good, and pleases God our Savior,

PEACEFUL AND QUIET (v2): Not to be comfortable and happy but for <u>MAXIMUM</u> spread of the Gospel!

ALL GODLINESS AND HOLINESS (v2)

- Godly To live a life <u>SEEKING GOD</u> in every aspect.
- Holy To live differently and <u>set apart</u> be a light to the people around us.

This is GOOD and PLEASES GOD our Savior (v3)

- This pleases the lord when we pray for others. When we SEEK HIS HELP. As we pray for unbelievers to be saved, this is right and pleases God!
- Judges 21:25 \rightarrow ²⁵ In those days Israel had no king; everyone did **as they saw fit.**

⁴ who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

PRAY FOR ALL PEOPLE

- One day, All TYPES OF PEOPLE FROM EVERY TRIBE AND TONGUE AND NATIONS Will worship God!
- All Standings → God desires ALL SORTS to be saved
- Share the Gospel everywhere → that is our job.
 Our job is not to figure out and judge who is saved.

⁵ For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, ⁶ who gave himself as a ransom **for all people.** This has now been witnessed to at the proper time.

Why must we pray... How will anyone be saved???
Because the only way everyone will be saved is by the one God and the one mediator, the man JESUS CHRIST.

Matthew 7:13-14 \rightarrow Enter through the <u>narrow gate</u>. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. ¹⁴ But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.

There is only one God and only one way to God. Any other way leads to Hell.

• Jesus GAVE HIMSELF as A RANSOM FOR ALL PEOPLE!!

• His Cross COVERS ALL in his perfect timing!!

"And for this purpose I was appointed a herald and an apostle—I am telling the truth, I am not lying—and a true and faithful teacher of the Gentiles.

⁸ Therefore I want the men everywhere to pray, lifting up holy hands without anger or disputing."

Our purpose as a herald and disciple is to **pray for all people** to know Christ.
