- A. "In real knowledge" refers not uncontrolled emotions, but divine love that is regulated by the knowledge of <u>God's</u> Word.
- B. "All discernment" refers to moral perception and "insight" (NIV). Real love is NOT blind.

- In Greek, the word "excellent" (*diaphero*) literally means 'to differ."
- Paul wanted the Philippians to know the difference between what was a <u>priority</u> or what was not; between what is better or "best" (NIV).

III. Pursues Integrity (vs.10b)



- The Greek word translated "sincere" means "genuine."
- Integrity is pursuing to live a life of genuine character; "blameless" or above reproach

Integrity will always produce righteous good works.

- "Fruit of righteousness" refers to the fruit that righteousness produces. These righteous deeds come only "through Jesus Christ."

 b. Confess your sins—be specific

⁹ that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; Romans 10:9

Dealing with sin (Romans 8:9,13)
 c. Replace your sin with something else—put to death your sin or your sin will put you to death (vs.13)
