





You can be God's hands and feet!


#### The Disciple's Progress 17:6-8

### Jesus prayed for His disciples'

PRESERVATION: "keep them in your name."

> The name of Jesus represents the character of his person.



The rabbis taught that Jerusalem's temple was destroyed because of *sinat chinam*, or "senseless hatred," between the many factions of the Jews.








## • What did John believe?




Why did John explain that their belief was not based on Scripture, but solely on the empty tomb?





#### Jesus Appears to the Ten




Thomas the doubter, refused to believe without seeing the *physical* body of Jesus.
