Four Dangers that God Protects us from:

- 1. The snare of the fowler (traps laid for us).
- 2. The deadly pestilence (diseases or troubles).
- 3. The terror by night (fear and anxiety).
- 4. The arrow that flies by day (attack from enemies).

1 John 2:15-17

¹⁵ Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them. ¹⁶ For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world. ¹⁷ The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever.

There are 3 sins that are **deadly interconnected traps**.

Fleshly Lust – Cravings for physical or sensual pleasure outside of God's will

Coveting/Jealousy – Comparison and discontentment

Pride of Life – Self-Glorification

"His Faithfulness" → Gospel Moment! We are not saved by our faith and abilties... but by His Faithfulness and Works!

Your Shield (Eph 6:10-11) \rightarrow ¹⁰ Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.
